### **Course Description:**

This lab course will assist students with preparation for activities that occur in MAT 019/030. It will also offer opportunities for review and remediation, subject to student needs.

### **Course Materials:**

Students are expected to bring the following to all Lab sessions:

- White Board, marker, & eraser (provided on 1st day of MAT 019); and
- Pencils with erasers.

### **Course Structure:**
